Water transport brought a whole new experience for the children as they "sailed" through an eventful week with lots to discover.

Language – We danced, sang and sailed our way with songs like "**Row Your Boat**", "**Sailing Pokey**" and "**Canoe Posey**". Learning about **parts of a sailboat** enabled us to increase our vocabulary. The information came in handy when we constructed our own sail boat. In **Jolly Phonics**, last week we met letter "**n**" and we threaded a necklace with beads and wire. All the other letters that we have learnt (s, a, t, i, p, n) came alive this week when we did a **revision** of letters learnt.

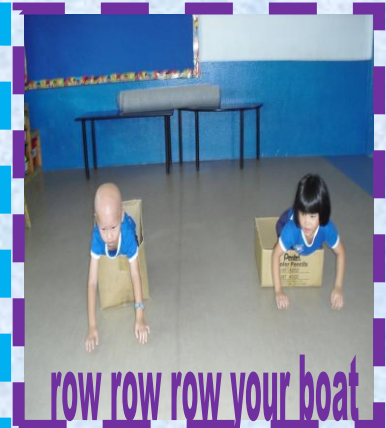

This week was a "soapy" event as we explored with **bubble printing** as well as making a **sailboat** of our own which we tried sailing during waterplay.
